

When people engage with each other spontaneously and informally, this can serve as a source of inspiration, innovation, and change. Facilitating a change of perspective that looks beyond job roles and hierarchies requires refreshing design ideas like the Sitzbockommel horse seat, which inspires both the body and the mind to try something different. You can sit astride, “ride side saddle,” or use it to lean on. Made from through-dyed polypropylene in four colors and weighing just 4.8 kg (10½ lbs), the seats are easy to place in groups, stack crosswise or pick up and take outside for a while. Anyone preferring a little more comfort can add a non-slip felt “saddle blanket” to their Sitzbock.

Its special shape and look featuring angled legs ensure that the Sitzbock pommel horse seats can be stacked at right angles without making the room look cluttered. Positioned in small “herds” they create an atmosphere that’s as fun as it is ergonomic, inviting users to change positions and interact with each other. They’re ideal in kitchenettes, lobbies, recreational areas, and workshop spaces as well as for team building al fresco.



204/11 graphite, 204/12 heather gray, 204/13 anthracite, 204/14 mango

A multipurpose seat, 707 mm (27⁷/₈ inches) in height, 627 mm (24¹¹/₁₆ inches) in width, and 520 mm (20⁷/₁₆ inches) deep when measured at the angled legs. It's made of through-dyed polypropylene with non-slip glides and comes with an optional felt saddle blanket.
